The New Rochelle Art Association 100th Annual Open Juried Show Call for Entries

Saturday, Sept. 19 - Sunday, Oct. 25, 2015
Opening Reception: Sunday, Sept. 27, 2015
Deadline: Friday, Sept. 4, 2015

Judge:

Carole Perry Artistic Director of The Edward Hopper House Art Center, Nyack, NY. She has an extensive background in curatorial work, having previously worked as an exhibition manager at the Guggenheim Museum and as a freelance curator for several years. She holds a MA in art history.

Media:

Oil and acrylic, watercolor, mixed media, pastel, graphics, sculpture, fine crafts and photography/digital. All work must be original (no giclee' prints) and completed within the last three years, not shown before in a NRAA Open Juried Show.

Awards:

There will be a minimum of \$2500.00 in cash and awards.

Opening Reception:

Sunday, September 27 (Art Fest), 5:15pm - 6:30pm

Eligibility:

Open to all artist 18 years and older. Artist may submit up to 2 entries. All 2D must be suitably framed, wired and ready to hang. All work must be finished and completely dried. Size of 2D

work must not exceed 36" x 48" inclusive of outside edge of frame. Triptychs should keep within the size parameter requirement. All sculpture must be firmly attached to a base. Crafts may not exceed 18" in height due to case size limitations. All work must be hand delivered and unpacked.

Entry Fee:

Members \$30.00 for 1 or 2 entries.
Non-members \$35 for 1 or 2 entries. Any one whose dues were not paid for the year 2015/2016 is considered a non-member. Payment is due by entry deadline. Payment does NOT guarantee acceptance by the Jury Selection Panel, which is a jury panel of five members of the NRAA.

Entry Instructions:

Jurying for acceptance is by jpegs sent to nraajuried2015@gmail.com or by CD's mailed to Gina Kingsley, 57 Rockland Place, New Rochelle, NY 10801.

- 1) The subject line of the email must read "Annual Open Juried Show"
- 2) Submission should be clearly marked: LAST name_FIRST name_TITLE_the number that corresponds with the works placement in the email or CD. JPEG images up to 8 inches, 300dpi or 4.7 MB.
Example: DaVinci_Leonardo_Mona Lisa_1.jpeg
- 3) In the body of the email, please list all the works submitted with the corresponding numbers, title, the medium, size, and price of each work.
- 4) The email must also include your contact information: Name, email, phone and physical address.

- 5) Entries not properly labeled with all information will not be considered.
- 6) a) Payment is by PayPal on the website www.nraaonline.org
b) Credit card (By clicking "Don't have a PayPal account").
c) Check (Mailed to Gina Kingsley, 57 Rockland Pl., New Rochelle, NY, 10801) and postmarked by Sept. 4, 2015.

Friday Sept., 11, 2015 on the website.

Delivery:

On Saturday, Sept. 19, 2015 at the New Rochelle Library, Lawton St., New Rochelle, NY. Artwork must be hand delivered to the New Rochelle Public Library on this day 10am - 1pm. Please refer to www.nrpl.org for directions to the library.

Removal of Work:

Work must be picked up Sunday, Oct. 25, 1:00pm - 3:00pm. Work not removed will be charged a \$5.00 per day storage fee. Work must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.

Liability:

Entries will be handled with all possible care. Since works will not be insured neither the NRAA or the New Rochelle Public Library or their employees will be responsible for loss or damage to any work submitted for any cause. Submitting an entry to this exhibition constitutes an agreement with all conditions of this exhibition and prospectus. NRAA assumes the right to photograph and use accepted works for documentation or publicity purpose.

The NRAA reserves the right to refuse any work that does not meet the requirements, does not appear as it's photo, is not wired properly, or is delivered late. No substitutes will be accepted.

Sales:

A commission of 20% will be charged on all sales generated through the exhibition. All works must be priced accordingly or marked "Not for Sale" (NFS). No "Price On Request (POR) works will be accepted.
